ADELE'S STORY

My two pups and I were abandoned near the shelter and were lucky to be saved by the volunteers and staff at Bay Area Pet Adoptions. They were able to quickly catch my pups, but I ran. My poor babies (Dorian and Lilly) were flea ridden and covered in fire ant bites. I tracked my pups to the shelter and began to hang out on the adjacent properties. BAPA left me food and water, but couldn't catch me. One day they placed Dorian in the front yard. I couldn't resist visiting my puppy and cautiously entered the gated grounds where they captured me. Everyone gave me lots of love and I gave them kisses! My pups have been adopted by a wonderful family, but I am heart worm positive and need treatment. I am one of three heart worm positive dogs at the shelter. Please consider adopting me when my treatment is done. I would be a great addition to your forever home. I am a sweet, easy going girl who likes other dogs and would happily curl up on your couch!

Heart worms are a dangerous and potentially fatal disease. They grow up to one foot long and reproduce in the dog's heart, lungs and blood vessels. Treatment is an invasive process and the injections that kill the heart worms are very hard on the infected dog. The dog must be kept still with no exercise or excitement for 60 days after treatment otherwise the heart worms can break loose and cause the dog to die by clogging their heart or lungs. At the shelter, heart worm positive dogs begin treatment with 30 days of Doxycycline, an antibiotic. After that, the injections are administered by a veterinarian. The dog is confined and carefully monitored for the next 60 days. Please help us to continue to provide this life saving treatment, Adele and the other dogs thank you.
